## **Elmden Rovers Youth Football Club Code of Conduct for Youth Players.2021-2022**

We all have a responsibility to promote high standards of behaviour in the game.

As a player, you have a big part to play.

That's why The FA is asking every player to follow a Respect Code of Conduct and Government guidelines

When playing football.

I will:

- Make sure I turn up for match / training with appropriate football attire. Including shin pads, Water Bottle and hand sanitiser.
- I understand the risks of spiting and will refrain from this.
- Always play to the best of my ability. Play fairly – I won't cheat, complain or waste time.
- Respect my team-mates, the other team, the referee or my coach/manager.
- Show respect with the other team and referee at the end of the game.
- Listen and respond to what my coach/team manager tells me. Play by the rules, as directed by the referee.
- Talk to someone I trust or the club welfare officer if I'm unhappy about anything at my club.
- Listen to my manager about how to enter and leave the training area / pitch. To reduce the risk of contracting Covid 19.
- I will not attend training session or match if I have any of the following symptoms:- **Have a high temperature (above 37.8oC). Have developed a new continuous cough. Have shortness of breath or a sore throat. Loss of or change in normal sense of taste or smell. Feeling unwell.**

I understand that if I do not follow the Code, any/all of the following actions may be taken by my club, County FA or the FA.

I may:

- Be required to apologise to my team-mates, the other team, and referee or team manager.
- Receive a formal warning from the coach or the club committee.
- Be dropped or substituted.
- Be suspended from training.
- Be required to leave the club.

In addition:

- My club, County FA or The FA may make my parent or carer aware of any infringements of the Code of Conduct.
- The FA/County FA could impose a fine and suspension against my club.

I have read and understood what is expected of me while representing Elmden Rovers Youth FC.
